- The value of mineral resources extracted in Ohio totaled approximately \$16.3 billion in 2022.
 - Natural Gas \$12.8 billion
 - Oil \$1.8 billion
 - Limestone and dolomite \$984.2 million
 - Other industrial minerals (sand & gravel, salt, sandstone, shale, clay, and peat) – \$612.4 million
 - Coal \$130.6 million
- Natural gas production neared 2.22 billion Mcf* in 2022. The top producing counties were:
 - Belmont 583.6 million Mcf
 - Jefferson 550.0 million Mcf
 - Monroe 423.8 million Mcf
- *Mcf = 1,000 cubic feet
- Harrison 314.6 million Mcf
- Carroll 94.2 million Mcf
